THROUGH COMMUNITY FUND PROGRAMS...

28,895 Liberty County residents were assisted by United Way of the Coastal Empire funded agencies in 2020. In addition, we supported over 2,000 residents by providing emergency resources and referrals at our Liberty Service Center. Below are some of the ways we made an impact...

OUR WORK

SAFETY NET

- 49,920 meals provided to students for evening or weekend food assistance
- \$25,154 in emergency assistance to 112 people
- \$203,413 COVID-19 Rapid Response Relief Fund dollars to assist 484 people
- \$20,000 CARES dollars to assist 162 households
- 23,000+ people received food assistance

UPWARD MOBILITY

- \$2,000,000+ in prescription savings cost
- 405 people received crisis and mental health counseling services
- 388 senior citizens received support services
- \$4,200 Women's United transportation assistance distributed to 201 community members
- 3,260 books purposed for students promoting early childhood literacy through Read United

MILITARY

- 93 active duty soldiers and their families provided with emergency financial assistance through the Landings Military Family Relief Fund
- 79 people provided with commissary cards to assist with household food insecurity through the Landings Soldier Food Voucher Program
