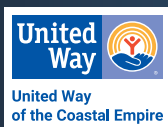

OUR WORK

THROUGH COMMUNITY FUND PROGRAMS



The Community Fund provided over **\$123,000** in grants to agencies located in and providing services to the citizens of Liberty County. As a result of this funding, **28,897** Liberty County residents were assisted by United Way of the Coastal Empire funded agencies in 2021. In addition, **783** residents were supported by providing emergency resources and referrals at the Liberty Service Center. Below are some of the ways we made an impact this past year.

SAFETY NET

- ▶ **53,244** meals provided to 493 students for evening or weekend food assistance
- ▶ **\$21,445** in emergency assistance distributed to 120 people
- ▶ **\$7,190** CARES dollars assisted 34 individuals

UPWARD MOBILITY

- ▶ **\$2,490** in transportation assistance distributed to nearly 100 community members
- ▶ **4,585** books provided to students to promote early childhood literacy through our Read United Program
- ▶ **398** senior citizens received supportive services
- ▶ **1,733** individuals received crisis and mental health counseling services

MILITARY

- ▶ **102** active duty soldiers and their families provided with emergency financial assistance
- ▶ **129** people provided with commissary cards to assist with household food insecurities
