- Raised over \$59,000 to assist residents of North Bryan County after the April 5, 2022 tornado
- Assisted 128 people (43 households)



OUR WORK THROUGH COMMUNITY FUND PROGRAMS



4,206 Bryan County residents were assisted by United Way of the Coastal Empire funded nonprofits in 2022. In addition, we supported over **365** residents by providing information and resources at our Bryan County Service Centers. Below are some of the ways we made an impact this past year.

SAFETY NET

- ▶ \$41,600 saved in prescription costs
- ▶ 549 senior citizens received in-home support
- 262 people without insurance or who were underinsured received essential services
- 1,275 Bryan County residents received free or low-cost food
- 96 counseling sessions provided to children and families impacted by child abuse

UPWARD MOBILITY

- 265 young people received leadership training
- 2,306 preschool through second-grade students received books to increase early childhood literacy
- 591 individuals screened for hearing or speech impairments
- 218 complimentary tax returns completed
