# OUR WORK THROUGH COMMUNITY FUND PROGRAMS



**12,296** Effingham County residents were assisted by United Way of the Coastal Empire funded nonprofits in 2022. Below are some of the ways we made an impact this past year.

#### **▶ VITA**

Processed 506 tax returns for free

#### ▶ Read United

Distributed over 2,650 new books to preschool through second-grade students in Effingham County

#### ► Read United Summer Program

Partnered with America's Second Harvest of Coastal Georgia for the Summer Feeding Program and distributed 374 books to children

#### Churches United

Assisted **24** families with housing, food, and utilities totaling **\$16,725** 

Contributed \$13,177 to support academic success in public schools through the Caring Closet program

Provided over \$1,495 in transportation aid to women and children in Effingham County
